



Application for British Columbia Veterans Licence Plates

British Columbia Veterans Commemorative Association

British Columbia Veteran licence plates are available to any member of the Canadian Armed Forces who has served and was honourably discharged or is currently serving, and has successfully underwent basic training.

VETERAN PLATE ELIGIBILITY

Members who meet any one of the following criteria are eligible to apply for a BC Veteran plate.

1. Served in WWII, Korea, Gulf War, the Balkan Wars, Afghanistan or other UN Peacekeeping Missions as a member of:
 - a. the Canadian Armed Forces, or
 - b. an Allied Force, or
 - c. the Canadian or Allied War Time Merchant Navy, and
 who has been honourably discharged or who is currently serving.
2. Served as a member of the Canadian Armed Forces, Regular or Reserves, who has been honourably discharged or who is currently serving, and has successfully completed basic training.
3. Served in UN or NATO Operations as a member of:
 - a. the Canadian Armed Forces, or
 - b. a UN or NATO Alliance Force serving in an Operation with the Canadian Armed Forces, and
 who has been honourably discharged or is currently serving.
4. Served in a UN or NATO Operation under command of the Canadian Armed Forces as a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, Municipal Police, or Correctional Services of Canada, who has been honourably discharged or is currently serving.
5. Served as a similarly qualified member of a British Commonwealth of Nations Armed Force and has been honourably discharged.

PROOF OF SERVICE DOCUMENTS

A photocopy of the appropriate proof of service documents must be submitted with your application. All service documentation will be returned to the applicant. No other type of documentation is acceptable.

1. **Discharged Members:**
 - Discharge Certificate or Certificate of Service
 - NDI 10, NDI 20, NDI 75
 - DND 2279 & CF 707 if less than 10 years service
 - CF54 if 10 or more years service
 - Library & Archives Canada Record of Service
2. **Currently Serving Members:**
Military Identification Card and Members Personal Record Resume (MPRR), NDI 10 and NDI 20.
3. **Royal Canadian Mounted Police, Municipal Police Service, Correctional Service of Canada:**
Certification from the officer in charge of Human Resources in your department stating the member has served under Canadian Armed Forces Command **in a UN or NATO Operation** and has been honourably discharged or is currently serving.

APPLY FOR A BC VETERANS LICENCE PLATE

Applications for BC Veterans licence plates are approved by the British Columbia Veterans Commemorative Association.

Approval is for the life of the Veteran. Re-approval is not required to obtain additional BC Veteran licence plates.

1. **Read** this application form in full and complete the Applicant Identification and Applicant's Service Information sections.
2. **Mail** your completed application form, a copy of your service documents, and your non-refundable payment of \$10 to the BC Veterans Commemorative Association (cheque or money order made payable to the BCVCA). Your approved application and all documents will be returned to you. **Incomplete applications will be returned.**
3. **Present** your approved application form and your Owner's Certificate of Insurance and Vehicle Licence to your Autoplan broker. Your broker will order your Veteran plates and contact you when they receive the plates.

Do not surrender your approved application to an ICBC Autoplan broker; keep it with your important documents.
